

RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

(To be executed by Participants over the age of 19)

WARNING! By signing this document, you will waive certain legal rights. Please read carefully

1. This is a binding legal agreement; therefore, clarify any questions or concerns before signing. As a Participant in the sport of softball and the orientation, instruction, activities, programs, and services of Softball BC (collectively the "Activities"), the undersigned acknowledges and agrees to the following terms:

Disclaimer

2. Softball BC, its directors, officers, committee members, members, employees, coaches, volunteers, officials, participants, agents, sponsors, owners/operators of applicable facilities, and representatives (collectively the "Organization") are not responsible for any injury, personal injury, damage, property damage, expense, loss of income or loss of any kind suffered by a Participant during, or as a result of, the Activities, caused in any manner whatsoever including, but not limited to, the negligence of Softball BC.

Description and Acknowledgement of Risks

- 3. I understand and acknowledge that
 - a) The Activities have foreseeable and unforeseeable inherent risks, hazards and dangers that no amount of care, caution or expertise can eliminate, including without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury, permanent disability, paralysis and loss of life; and
 - b) Softball BC has a difficult task to ensure safety and it is not infallible. Softball BC may be unaware of my fitness or abilities, may misjudge weather or environmental conditions, may give incomplete warnings or instructions, and the equipment being used might malfunction.
- 4. I am participating voluntarily in the Activities. In consideration of my participation, I hereby acknowledge that I am aware of the risks, dangers and hazards associated with or related to the Activities. The risks, dangers and hazards include, but are not limited to:
 - a) Executing strenuous and demanding physical techniques;
 - b) Vigorous physical exertion, strenuous cardiovascular workouts and rapid movements;
 - c) Exerting and stretching various muscle groups;
 - d) The failure to properly use any piece of equipment or from the mechanical failure of any piece of equipment;
 - e) Spinal cord injuries which may render me permanently paralyzed;
 - Serious injury to virtually all bones, joints, ligaments, muscles, tendons and other aspects of my body or to my general health and well-being;
 - g) Abrasions, sprains, strains, fractures, or dislocations;
 - h) Concussion or other head injuries, including but not limited to, closed head injury or blunt head trauma;
 - i) Physical contact with other participants, spectators, equipment, and hazards;
 - j) Grass, turf, and other surfaces including bacterial infections and rashes;
 - k) Collisions with fences, poles, stands, and softball equipment;
 - 1) Not wearing appropriate safety or protective equipment, such a helmet;
 - m) Failure to act safely or within my own ability or within designated areas;
 - n) Negligence of other persons, including other spectators, participants, or employees;
 - o) Weather conditions;
 - p) Travel to and from competitive events and associated non-competitive events which are an integral part of Softball BC's Activities; and
 - q) Negligence on the part of Softball BC, including failure on the part of Softball BC to take reasonable steps to safeguard or protect me from the risks, dangers and hazards associated with my participation in the Activities.

Terms

- 5. In consideration of Softball BC allowing me to participate in the Activities, I agree:
 - That my mental and physical condition is appropriate to participate in the Activities and I assume all risks related to my mental or physical condition;
 - To comply with the rules and regulations for participation in the Activities; b)
 - To comply with the rules of the facility or equipment;
 - That if I observe an unusual significant hazard or risk, I will remove myself from participation and bring such to the attention of a Softball BC representative immediately;
 - The risks associated with the Activities are increased when I am impaired and I agree not to participate if impaired in any way;
 - That it is my sole responsibility to assess whether any Activities are too difficult for me. By commencing f) an Activity, I acknowledge and accept the suitability and conditions of the Activity; and
 - That I am responsible for my choice of protective equipment and the secure fitting of that equipment.

Release of Liability and Disclaimer

- In consideration of Softball BC allowing me to participate, I agree:
 - a) That the sole responsibility for my safety remains with me;
 - To ASSUME all risks arising out of, associated with or related to my participation;
 - That I am not relying on any oral or written statements made by Softball BC or its agents, whether in a brochure or advertisement or in individual conversations, to agree to be involved in the Activities;
 - To WAIVE any and all claims that I may have now or in the future against Softball BC;
 - To freely ACCEPT AND FULLY ASSUME all such risks and possibility of personal injury, death, property damage, expense and related loss, including loss of income, resulting from my participation in the activities, events and programs of Softball BC; and
 - To FOREVER RELEASE Softball BC from any and all liability for any and all claims, demands, actions, damages (including direct, indirect, special and/or consequential), losses, actions, judgments, and costs (including legal fees) (collectively, the "Claims") which I have or may have in the future, that might arise out of, result from, or relate to my participation in the Activities, even though such Claims may have been caused by any manner whatsoever, including but not limited to, the negligence, gross negligence, negligent rescue, omissions, carelessness, breach of contract and/or breach of any statutory duty of care of Softball
 - That Softball BC is not responsible or liable for any damage to my vehicle, property, or equipment that may occur as a result of the Activities;
 - That negligence includes failure on the part of Softball BC to take reasonable steps to safeguard or protect me from the risks, dangers and hazards associated with the Activities; and
 - This release, waiver and indemnity is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by law of the Province of British Columbia and if any portion thereof is held invalid, the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

Jurisdiction

7. I agree that in the event that I file a lawsuit against Softball BC, I agree to do so solely in the province of British Columbia, Canada and further agree that the substantive law of British Columbia will apply without regard to conflict of law rules. I further agree that if any portion of this agreement is found to be void or unenforceable, the remaining document shall remain in full force and effect.
